



Pike Place Busker Rules

Daystall Short Sheets

ON PERFORMANCE TIMES:

- **1-hour time limit** for performances.
- Performers can continue past the hour limit *only* if no other buskers have queued to perform at that spot.
- When arriving at a spot with a busker who is currently playing, wait for a pause between songs to ask how much time they have left.
- Do *not* queue at multiple locations. Remain near the spot you wish to perform at.

ACOUSTIC PERFORMANCES ONLY, THE FOLLOWING ARE PROHIBITED:

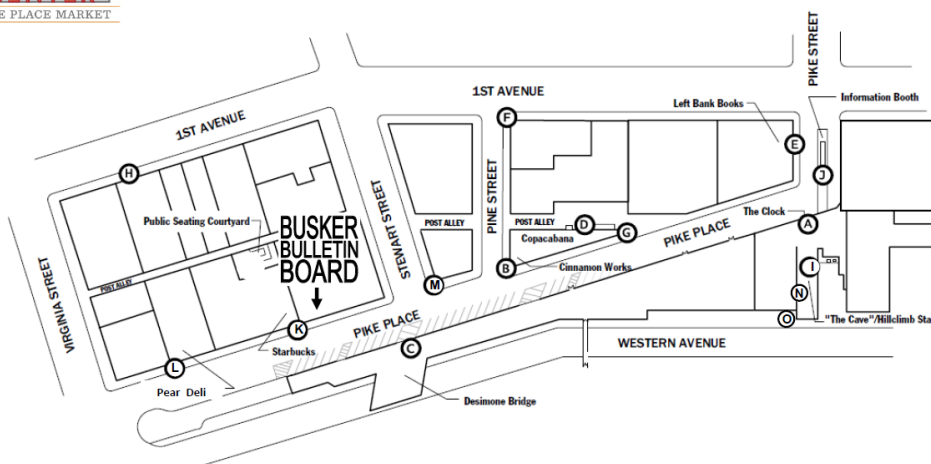
- Dangerous performances. (IE anything with fire, knives, cannons)
- Percussive beats, including any type of drums. (Tapping on a guitar for rhythm is fine)
- Brass instruments.
- Amplification of any kind.
- Performing under the influence of alcohol or illegal substances.
 - This is the *most common* reason buskers receive violations, and can result in having your permit revoked.

DISPLAYING YOUR BADGE:

- Make sure the permit is visible at all times while performing, either on your person or on your equipment.



Performer Locations



- A. Groups of 3 or 4 may perform here facing out into the street.
- B. The southeast corner of Pine Street and Pike Place.
- C. At the North Arcade entrance (at the foot of Stewart St.), on the Desimone Bridge. No performing is allowed at this location on Saturday.
- D. In the center of the courtyard of the Post Alley Building between that building and the Saniary Market building.
- E. Outside the flower shop on the sidewalk at the corner of First Avenue and Pike Street.
- F. On the sidewalk at the southwest corner of First Avenue and Pine Street.
- G. At the south tip of the Triangle Building near the metal stairs.
- H. On the First Avenue Courtyard adjacent to the main entrance to the Livingston Baker Apartments.
- I. On the walkway on the First Lower Level, along the Pike Street Hillclimb Corridor (the Cave).
- J. West of the Information Booth—in the middle of the sidewalk which runs along the south side of Pike Street separating Pike Street and Lower Pike Street.
- K. On the Pike Place sidewalk between Starbucks and the Stewart House.
- L. On the Pike Place sidewalk, in front of Pear Deli.
- M. Corner of Stewart and Pike Place.
- N. On the walkway on the second lower level, between the Pike Street Hillclimb Corridor and the bridge over Western Ave.
- O. On Pike Place sidewalk along Western Ave just North of the hillclimb stairs.

• No devices for electronic amplification of any sound are allowed. No brass instruments and drums are permitted. No other music is permitted at locations inside arcades or covered holding areas when played at levels which significantly interfere with normal verbal communication at the nearby places of business.

Numbers of Performers allowed at each Market location:

A (2) B(3) C(2) D(2) E(2) F(2) G(2) H(3) I(4) J(2) K(4) L(4) M(4) N(1) O(3)

- Performance spot C on the Desimone Bridge is closed on Saturdays.
- All other spots are open 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. seven days a week.
